Revision is vital for all students but it can lead to a great deal of stress and anxiety.

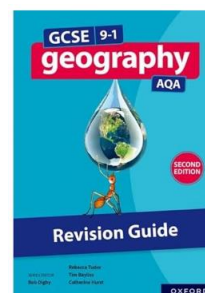
- Encourage your child to be using their free revision guides given to them by their geography teacher
